Incident: Conviction on Internet Crimes

Location: Columbia, Missouri

### Details:

On January 16, 2015, the Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force along with officers with the Boone County Sheriff's Department arrested Michael Moore of Columbia for Enticement of a Child and Attempted Statutory Rape 2<sup>nd</sup>.

The investigation leading to the arrest began early January 2015 when Moore started conversing through email with who he believed to be a 14 year old Boone County girl, but actually, was an undercover detective with the Cyber Crimes Task Force. After exchanging several emails Moore wanted to meet the child. Moore alleged to have enticed and encouraged the underage decoy child into meeting for the purpose of sexual conduct.

Arrangements were made by Moore to meet the child at a local gas station, however, when Moore arrived at the gas station, he was confronted by undercover detectives.

On Friday, September 18, 2015 Moore was sentenced to Enticement of a Child (5 years) and Attempted Statutory Rape 2<sup>nd</sup> (4 years) to run concurrent. The Missouri Enticement law carries a mandatory sentence to serve the full 5 years without the eligibility of probation or parole.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force is comprised of investigators from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, and the University of Missouri Police Department,.
