Details:

On Tuesday, December 13, 2016, a Boone County man was arrested for 1 count Possession of Child pornography, 1 video or 20 still images 2nd offense

The investigation began in August 2016 when the Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force was working proactive investigations involving the distribution and possession of child pornography files using the Internet.

The investigation leading to this arrest began when an investigator downloaded child pornography from a computer located in Columbia.

On December 13, 2016, a court ordered search warrant was served at a Columbia residence and several computers were seized. During an on-scene examination, the Task Force forensic examiner located multiple videos that depicted children involved in sex acts.

The suspect is identified as 25-year-old, Cody A. Woll who resides at 2012 West Ash Street, Apt I-16 located in Columbia, Missouri. Bond is to be set.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force is comprised of investigators from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the University of Missouri Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigations and the Boone County Prosecuting Attorney's office.
